Through a series of agency wide events, CPC is entering our 50th year of service as we reflect on our unique history.

Since our founding in 1965, CPC has become one of the largest social service providers for Asian Americans in the United States. Our mission is to serve the Chinese-American, immigrant and low-income communities in New York City by providing services, skills and resources towards economic self-sufficiency. CPC provides a range of services including child care, youth services, senior services, workforce development and community services.

This year we will be honoring seven outstanding individuals for their extraordinary contributions and dedication to the community:

- Honoree of the Year Joyce Chang, Managing Director, Head of Global Commodities Research, Corporate and Investment Bank, J.P. Morgan, one of the 25 Most Powerful Women in Finance 2014, and one of three bankers to be inducted into the Fixed Income Analyst Society Hall of Fame. Ms. Chang has inspired many women in finance and well as given back to the community in many ways.
- Leadership Awardees Gordon Lau, President of Lau N. Son Produce; has always given back
 to the community and supported various non-profit organizations in Chinatown. Michael E.
 Lee, Executive Director of Apex for Youth, a Chinatown based organization that connects
 youth to positive role models who guide and inspire youth to become confident youth adults
 who are ready for college and to give back to the community.
- Civic Leadership Award Yume Kitasei, Chief of Staff of Office of NYC Council Member Margaret Chin was indispensable during the Lower East Side's fight to save child care slots during the 2012 budget year. With her assistance and advocacy with Councilmember Chin, thousands of child care slots were preserved for the lower Manhattan community.
- Pioneer Award Allen B. Cohen was the former Executive Director of CPC and one of the first 5 employees to have been providing services at CPC. Mr. Cohen has been with CPC for over 40 years, advocating for the development of crucial social service programming to immigrant families. Before retiring Mr. Cohen envisioned CPC's Tribeca Learning Center, which now serves 100 children each year. Karen Liu was the former Assistant Executive Director of CPC and Director of CPC' Childcare Division. For over 37 years at CPC, Ms. Liu spearheaded the accreditation of CPC's Early Child Care Centers with National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) and grown the division tremendously. Ms. Liu continues to be a strong advocate for increased access to the arts, culture and literacy for children. Po-Ling Ng, CPC's Assistant Executive Director and Director of Senior Services was also one of the first 5 employees of CPC, as well as the first female employee in CPC. The title Ms. Ng is most proud of is Director of CPC's Open Door Senior Center, a model Asian American senior center for NYC serving seniors since 1972. Our Pioneer Awardees have seen CPC grow from a small store front on Pell Street to one of the leading Asian American social service agencies in the Tri-State area serving over 8,000 individuals each day through over 50 programs in 25 locations citywide.

This golden anniversary will only happen once. Your organization can become a part of CPC's legacy of service. Attached you will find an invitation and sponsorship form.
